

Adopt Complete Streets Policy

At **minimum**, include the following basic elements:

- Specify that “all users” include pedestrians, bicyclists, transit vehicle users and motorists, of all ages and abilities.
- Commit to create a comprehensive, integrated, connected multi-modal transportation network within the community.
- Recognize the need for flexibility and that all streets are different, and user needs must be balanced and fit into the context of the community.
- Apply to both new and retrofitted projects, including design, planning, construction, maintenance, and operations, for the entire right-of-way.
- Allow exceptions to the policy to be contingent upon the presence of specific safety concerns and set a clear procedure that requires high-level approval prior to granting exceptions.

Adopting a Complete Streets Policy that meets these criteria can earn 10 points toward Sustainable Jersey certification.
