- Complete a nomination form online.
- Identify a SRTS champion.  
(champions can be PTA/PTO reps, principals, teachers, parents, school officials, etc.).



- Complete First Step achievements.
- Endorsement letter from school or district.
- Hold **at least two** SRTS programs or events (walk/bike to school, bike rodeo, pedestrian safety education event, mileage club, etc).\*\*
- Implement **one** active transportation best practice (bike parking, kiss and walk drop off/pick up locations, staggered dismissals, safe routes to bus stops, etc.).



- Meet Bronze Level achievements.
- Complete **one** higher level SRTS project:
  - ◊ Bikeability or walkability assessment.
  - ◊ School-wide Student Travel Mode Tallies.
  - ◊ Hold **two** SRTS programs, events or active transportation best practice.
  - ◊ Ongoing year-round active travel program (Walking Wednesdays, Walking School Bus)



- Meet Silver Level achievements
- Show ongoing support from PTA, PTO, School Wellness Council, Green Team, etc.\*\*
- Complete **one** higher level SRTS project:
  - ◊ School Travel Plan.\*\*
  - ◊ Adopt a supportive SRTS policy.
  - ◊ An innovative project subject to approval.
