

WALKING TO SCHOOL SAFELY

- Be seen! Wear bright colors or clothing with reflective markers especially when it's dark.
- Always remember the "Three Golden Rules:"
 - * Walk (Don't Run)
 - * Stay on the Sidewalk
 - * Walk Sensibly (No Horsing Around)
- Stop and look Left-Right-Left behind and front before crossing the street. Keep watching for cars as you cross
- A "Walk" sign means its OK to cross but you still must pay attention
- A flashing "Don't Walk" sign means you should not start crossing. If you are already crossing when the flashing starts, continue crossing to the other side; do not turn back.
- If there is a crosswalk, use it. If not, cross streets at corners or intersections.
- Do not cross the street from between parked cars or run into the street.
- When there are no sidewalks, walk facing the traffic
- Always be sure to watch for cars that are turning and backing out of driveways or parking spaces.
