# To attain BRONZE level recognition for a school the following must be met:

**Endorsement/Support Letter of SRTS from School or School District.** Hold at least two pedestrian or bicycle safety education programs or walk and bike to school events AND implement one active transportation best practice (e.g. remote pick up/drop off, staggered dismissals, Safe Routes to bus stops, bike, scooter, skateboard parking, walking club for staff/reward staff that walk/bike to school). The education programs and events must have been held within twelve months of the submission date. The active transportation best practice must have been implemented within three years of the submission date and currently be utilized to benefit the school community. NOTE: This requirement also earns 10 points towards Sustainable Jersey for Schools certification!

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#### **Silver Level Recognition for Schools**

To atta	in SILVER level recognition for a school the following must be met:
	Meet Bronze level recognition requirements (endorsement letter from school/school district, hold at least <b>two</b> pedestrian or bicycle safety education programs or walk and bike to school events AND implement <b>one</b> active transportation best practice.
Silver a	applicants must also complete at least <b>ONE</b> of the following:
	A <u>walkability or bikeability assessment</u> around the school (must be <u>within 3 years</u> of the date of the submission date).
	School-wide <u>Student Travel Mode Tallies</u> (must be <u>within the past 2 years</u> of the submission date)
	Implement <b>two</b> pedestrian or bicycle safety education programs or walk and bike to school event or active transportation best practice. The education programs and events must have been held within twelve months of the submission date. The active transportation best practice must have been implemented within three years of the submission date and still be utilized to benefit the school community.
	Ongoing year-round active travel program (e.g. Walking Wednesdays, Walking School Bus).







#### **Gold Level Recognition for Schools**

The fol	llowing requirements are necessary to attain GOLD level recognition for a school:
	Meet Silver level recognition requirements (endorsement letters from school, and an added requirement of (1) <u>walkability or bikeability assessment</u> , (2) School-wide <u>Student Travel Mode Tallies</u> , (3) Total of 5 SRTS events or active transportation best practices, OR (4) ongoing year-round active travel program.
	AND
	Show ongoing support of SRTS from PTO, PTA, Green Team, School Administration, School Wellness Council, etc.
Gold a	pplicants must also complete at least <b>ONE</b> of the following:
	Complete a <u>School Travel Plan</u> which includes all 6 of the components.
	NOTE: This requirement earns 10 points towards Sustainable Jersey for Schools certification!
	Adopt a supportive walking and bicycling to school policy.
	NOTE: This requirement earns 10 points towards <u>Sustainable Jersey for Schools</u> certification!
	Implement an innovative walk/bike to school program or project, subject to approval.

#### **Champion's Information from Municipality:**

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## **Silver Level Recognition for Municipalities (Sustainable Jersey level)**

To attain SILVER level recognition for a municipality the following must be met:
Meet Bronze level recognition requirements (resolution/letter of support from municipality, as well as an added requirement).
AND, Silver applicants must also complete at least <u>ONE</u> of the following:
Annual training of all Crossing Guards including new crossing guards AND re-training of all returning crossing guards.
Manage/lead, provide staff or perform significant outreach for a total of 6 events or pedestrian and bicycle safety events (or an incremental of 4 events if completed two events from the Bronze list or requirements) within the past 2 years.
Implement an innovative SRTS project, subject to approval.
NOTE: Municipalities that attain Silver level SRTS Recognition receive 10 points toward  Sustainable Jersey certification!







## **Gold Level Recognition for Municipalities**

The fo	llowing requirements are necessary to attain GOLD level recognition for a school or school district:
	Meet Silver level recognition requirements (endorsement letter from municipality, and an added requirement.
	AND
	Show ongoing support of SRTS from PTO, PTA, Green Team, Borough Council, Borough Administration, etc.
	AND
	Adopt a Complete Streets Policy – which must meet minimum standards.  NOTE: Municipalities can earn 10 points toward <u>Sustainable Jersey</u> certification for this requirement!
Gold a	pplicants must also complete at least ONE of the following:
	Active participant in the completion of a <u>School Travel Plan</u> which includes all 6 components.  NOTE: Schools can earn 10 points toward <u>Sustainable Jersey for Schools</u> certification for this requirement
	Inclusion of a comprehensive municipal <u>Crossing Guard Policy</u> which <u>must</u> include the following sections: Training, Re-training and Uniform and Equipment.
	Innovative SRTS project, subject to approval.
