  - ♦ Annual Crossing Guard training for ALL guards.
  - ♦ Lead, provide staff or outreach for total of 6 SRTS events.
  - ♦ An innovative project subject to approval.



- Meet Silver Level achievements \*\*
- Show ongoing support Council, Green Team, etc.
- Adopt Complete Streets Policy meeting minimum requirements.\*\*
- Complete one higher level SRTS project:
  - ♦ School Travel Plan.\*\*
  - ♦ Comprehensive Crossing Guard Policy.
  - ♦ An innovative project subject to approval.
