Complete First Step Requirements

- Resolution of Support from municipality.
- Meet <u>one</u> higher level SRTS project:
 - ♦ Lead, provide staff or outreach for 2 SRTS events.
 - ♦ Post Observation Reports for 5 busiest Crossing Guard locations.
 - ♦ Innovate SRTS project subject to approval
 - ♦ Implement Bike/Ped infrastructure project



Meet Bronze Level Achievements*

- Complete **one** higher level SRTS project:
 - ♦ Annual Crossing Guard training for ALL guards.
 - ♦ Lead, provide staff or outreach for 2-4 additional SRTS events.
 - ♦ Implement Bike/Ped infrastructure project (can be used once)
 - ♦ Innovate SRTS project subject to approval (can be used once)



Meet Silver Level Achievements

- Show ongoing support Council, Green Team, etc.
- Adopt Complete Streets Policy meeting requirements.*
- Complete one higher level SRTS project:
 - ♦ School Travel Plan
 - Youth Council to address walking and bicycling
 - ♦ Comprehensive Crossing Guard Policy.
 - ♦ Innovate SRTS project subject to approval (can be used once)
 - ♦ Innovate SRTS project subject to approval (can be used once)
